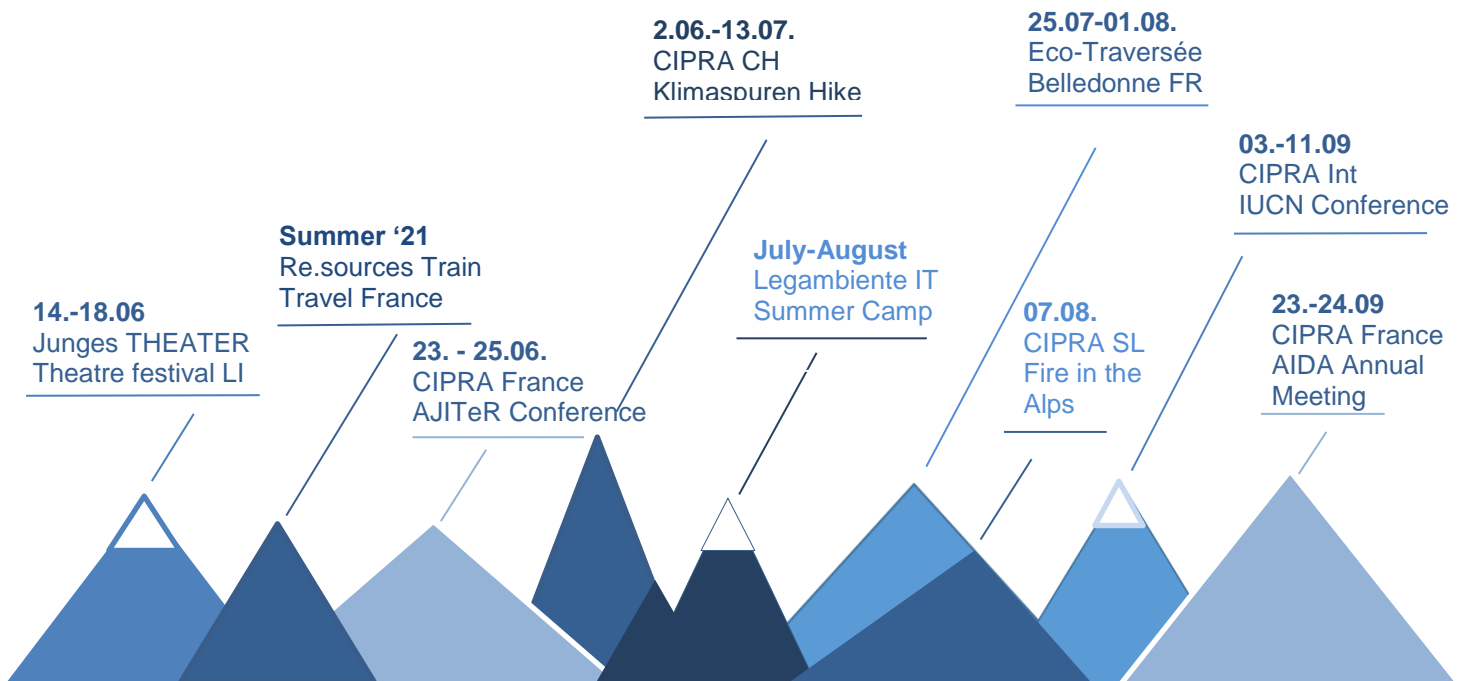

Jobshadowing gives you the opportunity to visit various project partners in the Alps and get an inside into their work. It is a great opportunity to see how NGOs work and to connect with experts in sustainable development or to see how theatre companies work. You can also contribute your ideas and participate in local events. The project offers 40 study visits with opportunities for discovering the work of environmental protection organisations and theatre companies.

How does it work?

- If you are interested to participate in job shadowing with one of the listed organisations, but not at the given date, feel free to ask the contact person regarding an alternative date.
- He/She will answer to all your questions and give you more information.
- A Job Shadowing lasts at least 3, maximum 7 days (travel days not included)
- Formalities: There is an agreement to sign at the beginning, and a report to write at the end.
- Costs for transport, food and accommodation will be reimbursed after you sent respective invoices to us

Description	<p>«La fabrique de terriens»: Our theater company will spend half a week in Gruffy, where we will offer two theatre workshops to the local people. We work with the ideas of the philosopher Bruno Latour. We ask ourself which resources are really necessary for our existence and if they are in danger or not.</p> <p>To explore these issues collectively, we propose different tools: voice and body exercises, writing and and body, writing and speaking. In this process, art and play are used as a way to capture and describe a personal reality and to be able to share it.</p> <p>The aim of the «Fabrique de Terriens» is to allow everyone to express themselves in a friendly but rigorous framework. Our work is based on the art of presence: promoting awareness of the here-and-now, strengthen the body's anchoring to the ground, develop sensitivity to the relational space between the participants.</p> <p>This is why coming back to earth makes sense on a theatre stage: it is there that we can measure the importance of each gesture, each inflection of the voice, each moment.</p> <p>Job Shadowees are welcome to participate in and/or help out at the workshops. A great opportunity to get to know our work.</p>

Different stakeholders (institutional partners, French associations) will meet to discuss the actions realised in the French Alps for the upcoming year. The next day the final conference of the AJITeR project will take place.</p> <p>About the project:</p> <p>Many rural areas are faced with the challenge of facilitating the sustainable settlement of young adults between the ages of 17 and 35. New practices and new development in terms of employment, improving the quality of life, particularly through access to services, and deepening citizen participation needs to be shown. The AJITeR project is a 3-year project to capitalise, promote and disseminate good practices on the theme of welcoming and settling young adults in rural areas.</p>

Description	<p>We are trying to promote the implementation of a French Alpine ticket. On the one hand, this includes a study of the tickets that are already available for young people to travel sustainably and climate-friendly in the French Alpine region. Another important step will be political lobbying - talks with regional representatives of the three regions as well as with the French EUSALP presidency are planned for the coming months.</p> <p>During the summer months, young people will travel for a fortnight through the French Alps by public transport - testing train and bus connections and communicating about initiatives, actions and highlights (social media as well as a French AlpTick card with interesting information about their stops and discoveries).</p>

Motivated to travel together within a small group, open minded and interested in discovering the French Alps, communication skills and social media skills for communicating on the travel is necessary. Description	<p>During Legambiente summer camps organized in previous years, the volunteers were engaged in monitoring, within the Site of Community Importance (SIC) "Stazione di Myricaria germanica" about protected species included in the Habitat Directive. The volunteers were also involved in the maintenance of a GTA path. These interventions improve the network of pathways to link the small village of Villar Pellice to the main town of the valley, Torre Pellice. During the 2019 summer camp, we also had the opportunity to participate in the Rakaboom Eco-Festival. Besides these activities, there were "lessons" made by specialists like ecologists and botanists about naturalistic aspects of the mountain area. During the free time, we usually organized excursions to the Peyronel botanical garden (the higher garden of Europe), Other activities including dips (very refreshing) in the rivers of the valley; visits and participation in agricultural productions (honey extraction, cheese making); guided visits to the Waldensian Historical Places of the valley; observations of the stars; dances with traditional Occitan music from these valleys.</p>
Language	It would be better to have some knowledge of Italian language.
Special tasks for the Jobshadowee	Interest in natural issues (the training will take place on-site anyway). Predisposition for work in natural environments (sun, wind, insects, tall grass). Good attitude and training in walking (daily movements of a few km; climbs in altitude for a difference in height of about 1000m).
Accommodation possibilities and prices	Accommodation will take place at an elementary school. More rooms (classrooms) with spartan beds (camp beds) will be available. The school's toilets will be available, but since the showers are not present, external solar showers will be set up and the closed, hot showers of the adjacent campsite will be available.

What – short description what it is about	<p>In Slovenia, a procedure to electrify the highest mountain hut came to public. Such changes would have unprecedented influence to fragile mountain habitat, as the facility would suddenly be able to offer almost hotel services. CIPRA Slovenia launched a series of educational and promotional events titled «The Issues of the Mountain World», covering sustainability, climate change, visitor management, outlining the desired (and sustainable) future of mountaineering. The activities will be wrapped-up in one/two-day international «Fire in the Alps» events (planned as excursion, round-table discussion, short movie, interviews, proposals for legislation changes).</p> <p>At all stages of the activity, we will closely collaborate with young people, give their ideas visibility and encourage interchange of knowledge and experiences.</p> <p>Activities will be done in Slovenian language.</p>
